

Good afternoon,

This morning the Cabinet Secretary for the Environment, Climate Change and Land Reform has laid Regulations in the Scottish Parliament that will create the legal framework for the Scottish Government's Deposit Return Scheme. These Regulations also contain the go-live date for the scheme, **of July 2022**. Alongside the Regulations, the Cabinet Secretary has laid *The Environmental Regulation (Enforcement Measures) (Scotland) Amendment Order 2020*. That Order confers additional powers on the Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA) to enable it to enforce the requirements of the DRS Regulations.

*The Regulations will now lie before the Scottish Parliament for fifty-four days to allow a further period of scrutiny. There will then be a vote on the Regulations in the Scottish Parliament. This is the final step in the Parliamentary process after which the scheme will become law.*
